

## **Super Bowl Squares Fundraiser for OLV School**

### **How It Works:**

- There are 100 squares available in total.

### **How to Participate:**

1. Purchase a square for \$127.50 through the Fixed Price menu item.

3. Each square will have a new set of numbers for each quarter of the game, so you get multiple chances to win!

### **Cash Prizes:**

There are four chances to win cash during the Super Bowl game:

- End of First Quarter: \$500
- End of Second Quarter: \$1,000
- End of Third Quarter: \$500
- End of Game: \$1,500

Each quarter, numbers will be randomly assigned to each square, so your numbers will change with every quarter. The winner is determined by the last digit of the teams' scores at the end of each quarter.
